Task of the week

Are you ready to swim with the sharks? This one-week training event will prepare you for this exact moment. From 12th to 16th March you will discover the dirty secrets of turning a good (or bad) idea into a successful clinical product. We will coach you into identifying the clinical needs in the current market, concocting a business plan, performing sophisticated risk assessments and everything that you need to know to build that bullet-proof business concept.

Armed with this knowledge, you will work throughout the week together with a team of 4-5 fellow students to design a business plan that tackles a clinical need (can be anything from a device, concept, or software). We will implement the concept of the famous show which gives entrepreneurs the opportunity to sell their ideas to a team of successful businessmen/women who are ready to invest in their company. So, as the show goes, you will have a very short timeframe (< 10min) to convince the local jury that your idea is worth the money. The winning team does not only get to survive the "sharks attack", but they will also get a prize!
